# \$18,000 Reward



The Citizens Crime Commission, Lansdowne Police Department and Yeadon Police Department are seeking the public's help in identifying the person(s) responsible for making terroristic threats and setting fire to the Penn Wood High School - Green Avenue Campus in Lansdowne, PA and making terroristic threats at the Penn Wood High School - Cypress Street Campus in Yeadon PA.

The Citizens Crime Commission is administering an \$18,000 reward. \$1,700 reward posted by the William Penn School District and \$300 from a concerned citizen. Added to the fund will be an additional \$16,000. Senator Anthony Williams pledged \$8,000, the office of Representative Ronald Waters pledged \$5,000, and ARAMARK pledged \$3,000. The reward is for any information that would lead to the arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for this senseless crime.
